Linguistics Department Position: Modes of Teaching

A number of issues came up during the deliberations. Members of staff affirmed the 'return to campus' doctrine in 2023 as maintained in the documentation. First year lectures and tutorials will be on campus as per A&H guidelines (bullet 7). All second- and third-year lectures will be face-to-face on campus. However, there was a debate on retaining some level of online tutorial presence as per bullet 3; not just for static uploading of lectures and (narrated) PowerPoints but for interactive online tutorial sessions alternating with the physical classroom tutorials. Related to this, there was concern expressed regarding the undergraduate tutorial programme. The department usually has a large number of students registered in the first-year programme, and increasingly many decide to continue with the modules at second- and third-year levels. Our first-year tutorials are held weekly and the second- and third-year tutorials are biweekly, alternating the offered modules per semester. Just before and during Covid 19 Lockdown, we experienced tutor shortages. As much as we always prioritise the first year in terms of tutor allocation whenever there is a shortfall in availability of tutors, during the discussion, it became clear that had it not been for the online tutorial space (which could accommodate many students with one tutor in attendance), our second year and third year tutorial programmes would have collapsed. If our tutorial programmes were limited to the physical space, we would need many more tutors, as there is a limited number of tutors to comfortably accommodate students in physical classrooms.

A number of staff in the department have devised and designed curricula in which delivery bridges virtual (online) and physical spaces into a seamless interactive space. These endeavours started before covid and were further developed and improved during the pandemic. During the discussion it was strongly expressed that some of the positive developments and lessons learnt during online teaching and learning during the pandemic should be carried forward.

Almost all the honours (6 out of 7) modules have opted for 50% face-to-face and 50% online seminars. A number of students are employed and in the past, it was difficult to accommodate such students in our honours programme as they found it a challenge to attend classes. They needed to take time off and either drive or take public transport to the university every week, and get back to their homes sometimes after 18.00hrs. In addition, finding venues for postgraduate teaching has always been a challenge as such programmes are not usually on the time table.

The department recognizes that online teaching and the design of 'smart' online courses represent potentials of growth for the faculty. In the past two years, online teaching has provided our postgraduate students the platform and experience to get employed as online teachers and course designers. The department sees the online space as an area for growth in both undergraduate and postgraduate student recruitment.

As allowed for as in the SAP Principles Guideline, the department would have preferred to have the opportunity to quantify the percentages for modes to be used in teaching e.g. 20-30% interactive online

and 70-80% face to face for second and third year modules. Outside the breakdown on the timetable, the online material accumulated during covid will still be used to complement the face-to-face material. The department therefore thinks that the faculty could have been more open to give an opportunity to choose from the various SAP Principles. Given our undergraduate modules (10 credits), the request for the department to choose modes as well as the conditions to be adhered to really present the department with no choices as far as teaching is concerned. The position taken by the faculty is too restrictive and seems to take us back to a time before iKamva. The raised issues around timetabling and 10 credits modules could still be navigated easily and we do not see them as reasons to stop us from adding the online breakdown as indicated above. However, taking the position of the faculty into consideration, below are the options for our modules:
